

GENERAL RULES AND GUIDELINES

1. The safety of both the rider and horse is of paramount importance.
2. The judge's decision is final.
3. Helmets are required in over fence classes and encouraged in all classes.
4. Show attire is not necessary. Long pants and sleeved shirts are required.
5. Heeled riding boots are required in all classes.
6. Any unruly horse will be excused at the sole discretion of the show staff.
7. Stallions are not permitted at Garrod Farms
8. No horses under the age of 3 in performance classes.
9. Youth exhibitors (17 & under) must have their entry forms signed by a parent or guardian before they can receive a number to enter the arena.
10. Entries close two classes prior to the class of entry.
11. Management reserves the right to combine, cancel or split classes
12. 2-minute gate call will be strictly enforced. NO refunds for missed classes.
13. Tack changes (3 minutes) must be requested 3 classes in advance.
14. All dogs and pets must be leashed and non-disruptive at all times.
15. Patterns will be posted at least one-hour prior to class.
16. Walk/trot & Walk/jog participants may not enter in canter/lope classes.
17. Classes marked with "A" are counted towards the division you qualify for. Does not count towards Open.
18. Ribbons will be awarded 1st through 5th place.
19. Daily High Point will be awarded at the end of each show to the horse & rider combination with the most points All Around and in each division: English Walk/ Trot, English 21 & Under, English Over 21, English Open, Western Walk/Jog, Western Rookie, Western Amateur All Ages, Western Open. The point scale will be 6-4-3-2-1
20. A buckle for Western and the halter for English will be awarded to the horse & rider combination with the most points at the end of the series in the following divisions: English Walk/ Trot, English 21 & Under, English Over 21, English Open, Western Walk/Jog, Western Rookie, Western Amateur All Ages, Western Open
21. Classes marked with a ^ shall count towards the high point award for the age division you compete in. Does not count towards the Open division High Point.
22. Classes 1-18 will be held in the upper jumping arena.
23. Classes 2, 6, 7, and 8: courses set at 250 meters, rider closest to the optimum time wins. Optimum time posted the day of the show.
24. Class 19-35 will be held in the main arena.
25. Classes 20-23 Trail classes may be entered by both English and Western riders however points don't count towards English high point.
26. Paid Trail Warm Up is available on a first come first served basis. \$10 for 5 minutes, limited to 12 riders. Riders may only do one warm up per show.
27. High point winners must participate and attend in final show on August 5th.
28. Show Office will open an hour prior to start of each show.
29. Western will start no earlier than 12:00pm.
