INTRODUCTION:

Garrod Farms Western Club, is an advanced western riding club that is designed for equestrians who are already riding on a regular weekly basis. This club is for equestrians seeking to learn more about horse care, showing, and advance their riding skills in the Western discipline. Students will learn advanced riding maneuvers, techniques, and develop stronger horsemanship skills. The Club will introduce a variety of western disciplines, including but not limited to Western Pleasure, Ranch Versatility, Reining, Cowhorse, Trail Riding, Mounted Shooting, and ridden patterns. Patterns may include Horsemanship, Ranch Riding, Ranch Trail (obstacles), Showmanship (unmounted pattern) and modified Reining and Cow Horse patterns. Trail obstacles may include ground poles, caveleties, working a gate, log drag, working a rope, going over a bridge, and more. Members will also learn how to properly set up trail courses, how to execute patterns, and how to prepare for a show and what to expect (what judges look for). Members will work closely together and will create bonds, support one another, learn from each other, and most importantly, practice good sportsmanship.

CLUB RATES:

- Monthly Club Membership Fee for members using a Garrod Farms Horse:
 - \$120 flat rate per month
 - Includes horse rental (for monthly lessons), friendships, & practice for shows & more!
- Monthly Club Membership Fee for Garrod Farms boarders & leasers:
 - \$100 flat rate per month
 - Includes discounted rate, friends to ride with, practice for shows & more!

REQUIREMENTS:

- Garrod Farms Students:
 - Must be a current student in lessons at least once per week (group or private lessons through Garrod).
 - Must be at least 13 years old.
 - Must be able to **memorize** and **execute** a Western Riding Test.
- Garrod Farms Staff & Trainees:
 - Must be a current staff member or Level 3 Trainee
- Garrod Farms Boarder (or Leaser) with own horse and equipment:
 - Must be a current boarder or a lessee with approval from owner for rider to participate with horse.
 - Must be at least 13 years old.
 - Must be able to **memorize** and **execute** a Western Riding Test.
